General Instructions For The Preparation of Scientific Poster

- ❖ The content of the poster shall be clear, concise and eye-catching.
- ❖ Scientific content shall be focused on the intended message clearly conveyed through simple layman language.
- ❖ Content of the poster shall be **Title, Introduction, Need for the study, Materials & Method, Statistical analysis, Result & Discussion, Summary & Conclusion, Acknowledgement and References.**
- ❖ The title shall be concise and short reflecting the content of the research work and it should not be more than **75 words.**
- ❖ The author's name shall be in bold, and the, presenting author shall be denoted with a * **mark and underlined. Prefix like, Dr., Mr. Mrs. shall not be mentioned in the author's name** and even qualifications need not be mentioned.
- ❖ Affiliation of authors shall be clearly mentioned by using superscript numerical.
- ❖ Shall provide mail ID and contact number of presenting authors below Affiliation.
- ❖ **Introduction:** Shall not be more than 10 lines, it should reflect the current research problem and why the current research is being undertaken
- ❖ **Need for the study:** Shall not exceed 2 lines and explain the research envisaged and hypothesis of the study
- ❖ **Materials and methods:** Shall not exceed 20 lines, list out important materials used for the study. Explain the methods in brief and not required to explain the already existing methods
- ❖ **Statistical Analysis:** Shall explain the tools used for the analysis and shall not exceed two lines.
- ❖ **Results and Discussion:** Present either Tables or graphical form and not both. Captions to tables and figures shall present at the top and any information can be presented at the bottom or footnote. Statistical findings shall be presented for all tables and figures. The discussion section may be given as a separate section, where the research findings can be discussed with relevant references. It shall not contain more than 10 lines.
- ❖ **Summary Conclusion:** Shall be brief and concise and shall not exceed three lines.
- ❖ **Acknowledgement:** Shall be written in brief not exceeding two lines
- ❖ **References:** Shall follow Vancouver's study of referencing style. The reference can be cited in the running text by Superscript unbracket.
- ❖ **Font:** Times New Roman
- ❖ **Font Size:** Title- 60 points Bold and caps,
 - 45 points for Author's name 35 Points for Affiliations, 30 Points bold for headings and subheadings, 20-26 points normal for running text.
- ❖ No fancy fonts can be used
- ❖ The preferred background shall be white, font color must be black only and no color font shall be used.
- ❖ **Poster Size**
 - 3 feet width × 4 Feet Height (90cm width ×120 cm height).
 - **Please note:** Posters larger than this cannot be accommodated.
